The Wines:

**2014 Leonetti Cellar Cabernet Sauvignon \$145** Blackcurrants, black raspberries, graphite, leafy herbs and even a hint of bay leaf all emerge from the 2014 Walla Walla Cabernet Sauvignon, and it's deep, rich and beautifully concentrated in the vintage. Made from 81% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Petit Verdot and 8% Merlot, it opens up nicely with time in the glass, has ample tannin structure and a great finish. Give bottles short term cellaring and enjoy through 2034. **94 Points Wine Advocate**

**2014 Abeja Columbia Valley Cabernet Sauvignon \$54**

This Cabernet is stylish, elegant, and impeccably balanced. This is accomplished through meticulous viticultural management, utilization of a rare sorting system, gentle handling of the fruit and the wine, customized practices for every lot no matter how small, and carefully selected French oak.

This flagship wine offers dense blackberry and ripe black cherry aromas that give way to shaved semi-sweet chocolate, blueberry pie and vanilla bean on the palate. Hints of cinnamon, sage and graham cracker circle back around to a lengthy finish loading with cassis, plum and boysenberry. Sourced from some of the most established vineyards in the Columbia Valley along with grapes from the Walla Walla Valley Heather Hill Vineyard.

**2013 DeLille Cellars D-2 \$38**

Broad and open-textured, with tannins surrounding a plush core of green olive-accented dark plum, thyme and spice, lingering easily on the undulating finish. Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Best from 2017 through 2023. **92 Points Wine Spectator**

**2014 Watermill Cabernet Sauvignon \$29**

This wine boasts a nose of cassis, blackberry, graphite, and mocha. The palate is concentrated and mirrors similar flavors to the nose with a slight smoke element. The long finish is framed by finely grained tannin.

**2015 Tamarack Cellars Cabernet Franc \$25**

Precise and open-knit, with a vibrant core of blueberry, bell pepper and spice flavors that glide easily through a polished finish. Drink now through 2023. **91 Points Wine Spectator**

**2013 Saviah Cabernet Franc, Walla Walla Valley \$29**

This exceptional Cabernet Franc opens with earthy aromas of nutmeg and fresh cracked pepper and bright cherry and bramble berry notes. Supple, well textured tannins support the flavors of red fruit, anise, and blackberry. Smooth barrel spice influences and lively acidity fill the palate and lead to a spice-dusted raspberry finish.
