The Wines:

2014 Pine Ridge Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon \$62

The bottled 2014s include the 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon from Napa, which is 93% Cabernet Sauvignon and 7% Petit Verdot. A classic much in keeping with the vintage characteristics, this charmer is loaded with sweet black and red currant fruit, some spice box, earth, and subtle oak. It is up-front, irresistible, full-bodied and layered with fruit and glycerin. The finish displays sweet tannin and the wine can be drunk now or cellared between 15-20 years. **92 Points Robert Parker**

2012 Stuhlmuller Estate Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$40

The 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Estate displays lots of chocolaty, crème de cassis, cedarwood and spice notes intertwined with a hint of oak. Full-bodied, rich, concentrated and youthful as well as approachable, it should drink well for 15 or more years.

2014 Abeja Cabernet Sauvignon \$54

This is the grape that we believe will increasingly be recognized as the icon varietal of Washington State and comprises the majority of our production. This Cabernet is stylish, elegant, and impeccably balanced. We accomplish this by meticulous viticultural management, utilization of a rare sorting system, gentle handling of the fruit and the wine, customized practices for every lot no matter how small, and carefully selected French oak.

2014 Napa Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$25

Started by Rombauer back in the 80's Napa Cellars is now owned by the Trinchero Family Estate. As a result they are able to source premium Napa fruit from their almost 300 acres of estate vineyards in Napa Valley.

2013 St Supery Estate Cabernet Sauvignon \$40

The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon Estate, which spent 18 months in new French oak, is sexy. Loads of blueberry and dark black raspberry notes soar from the glass of this cedary, spicy, medium to full-bodied wine. It shows good purity, a lush, seductive fragrance and mouthfeel, and a long, heady finish. It is drinking well now but should continue to evolve for up to 10-15 years. **91 Points Robert Parker**

2014 Mercer Canyon Estate Cabernet Sauvignon WA \$23

Aromas of blueberry, dark plum, and blackberry jam are elevated with hints of tobacco, caramel, and sweet vanilla. The lush fruit continues in the palate with a nice lift of mint. The well integrated oak and sleek tannins lead into a velvety finish with a nice touch of acidity on the end. This Cabernet Sauvignon is a lovely balance of power and grace.

The grapes for this wine come from our acclaimed estate vineyards in the Horse Heaven Hills.
