### **2011 Cavallotto Dolcetto d-Alba Vigna Sco \$18**

Flows with gorgeous dark fruit, tar, licorice and underbrush. As always, this is a beautiful, supple Dolcetto with superb purity in its fruit, beautifully articulated aromatics and terrific overall balance. It is highly recommended. A stunning wine indeed.

### **2011 Greywacke Sauvignon Blanc New Z. \$19**

This intriguing white delivers a complex aromatic note that includes whiffs of petrol, oolong tea, mineral giving way to an equally complex flavor profile. Crunchy green apple, Meyer lemon and melon flavors are refreshing, balanced, and persistent on the finish. Drink now. **92 Points Wine Spectator**

In this month's hand-picked Cheap & Cheerful Six-Packs for July you will find incredible wine values from France, Washington, Italy, Spain, Argentina & California. ### **2012 Padrillos Malbec Argentina \$10**

The 2012 Padrillos Malbec is from the Uco Valley and is raised in French and American oak for eight months. It has a clean, generous bouquet of dark cherry, Dorset plum and blueberry that is generous and rounded. The palate is sweet and rounded with soft tannins. It is silky smooth and slips down the throat with ease. This is a consummate easy-drinking Malbec that you will finish sooner than you think – so pleasurable it is. Drink now.

### **2010 Bodegas Montebuena Rioja Spain \$11**

(100% Tempranillo, raised entirely in American oak): Vivid ruby. Ripe cherry and blackcurrant on the nose and in the mouth. Pliant and seamless in texture, with good heft and back-end energy. Finishes smooth and sweet, with fine-grained tannins providing shape and grip. An excellent value for Rioja.

### **2011 Cristia Grenache France \$13**

Old Grenache vines with real character, well-matched by oak which accentuates the sweetness and softness of the wine. As this is the first vintage, it is difficult to assess its longevity so this figure may be revised from time to time - it's academic anyway: no-one is going to keep such a delicious wine for long!

### **NV Bookwalter Notebook C.V. WA Red Blend \$10**

The wines aromatics display a complex array of red fruits like black cherries, plums, red currants and figs wrapped with resin, caramel, cedar and hints of fresh and dried herbs. The wine enters the palate sweet and then rolls into a well-rounded mid-palate where the bright red fruits erupt. Secondary flavors of bakers chocolate, pomegranate, toast, dried herbs, tobacco and cola are followed by a smooth, lingering finish that is complimented by the natural sweetness and acidity of the wine.

### **2010 Wahluke Slope Cabernet Sauvignon WA \$14**

Smooth, supple re that is eminently approachable in its youth and priced to enjoy any night of the week. It opens with aromas of ripe raspberry, Belgian chocolate and black licorice. On the palate, it unveils plush, delicious flavors of boysenberry, black pepper, ripe plum and dark chocolate. Moderate tannins provide plenty of intensity on the entry and ample structure throughout.

### **2012 Line 39 Petite Sirah Central Coast CA. \$10**

The Petite Sirah offers aromas of red and black fruits, with a hint of oak. A full-bodied wine that is both complex and elegant. This Petite Sirah calls out for big, juicy steak.
