2014 Altovinum Evodia Grenache Spain \$11

This blend of 90% Grenache and 10% Syrah aged in concrete and demi-muid is a custom cuvée from importer Eric Solomon. Made from very old head-pruned vines that are not irrigated in pure slate soils, some of the vines are close to 100 years of age. This is really an amazing wine for the price. It is a fruit bomb, so those not wanting flavor, or in search of wimpy wines need to consider a light beer. Deep ruby/plum purple, with loads of blueberry and black currant fruit, underlying crushed rock notes and some floral scents are all present in this remarkable wine that sells at a full retail markup of \$10.00, which is simply incredible! These are the kind of wines I wish had existed when I was in college. **90 Points Robert Parker**

2014 Sarraill Cabernet Franc , France \$11

The 2014 Cabernet Franc Reserva is grapy and juicy, nothing herbal about it, and has some cracked peppercorn aromas. It has a soft texture with polished tannins and acidity. A sleek Cab Franc

2014 Cusumano Nero D'Avola Sicily \$12

Here's a solid value wine from sunny Sicily. The 2014 Nero d'Avola from the Cusumano brothers is full of great surprises this year and I am very pleased with the results. The 2014 vintage shows a big jump in quality over previous years. Closed with a glass cork, the wine pours out of the bottle to show a saturated

and rich appearance. Aromas of dark berry, tobacco leaf, moist earth and olive tapenade are well presented and balanced. Well done. **89 Points Robert Parker**

2013 Kaiken Malbec Reserva Argentina \$11.50

This ripe red is filled with plenty of dark chocolate and Asian spice notes up front, wrapped around flavors of roasted plum, dark currant and wild herb. Features a luscious mouthfeel, with a finish supported by medium-grained tannins. Drink now through 2020. **91 Points Wine Spectator**

2014 Skyfall Red Blend WA \$13

Deep ruby. Red cherry aroma. Dry, medium plus bodied. Medium plus acidity. Medium tannins. Easy rolled tannins with an oak hint. Nice balanced flavor. Just enough alcohol present to make it worth it. Ok and recommended for a quick midnight drink at a tapas.

2013 Seven Falls Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon WA \$14

Ripe black cherry and boysenberry fruit flavors are layered with notes of caramel, mocha and black tea. This concentrated, full bodied wine has a smooth lasting finish.
